Gold ore is broken into small pieces, grounded into slurry or powder, dissolves in chemical mixture, goes through various drying, screening, and "electrowinning" process to get gold particles from the Ore

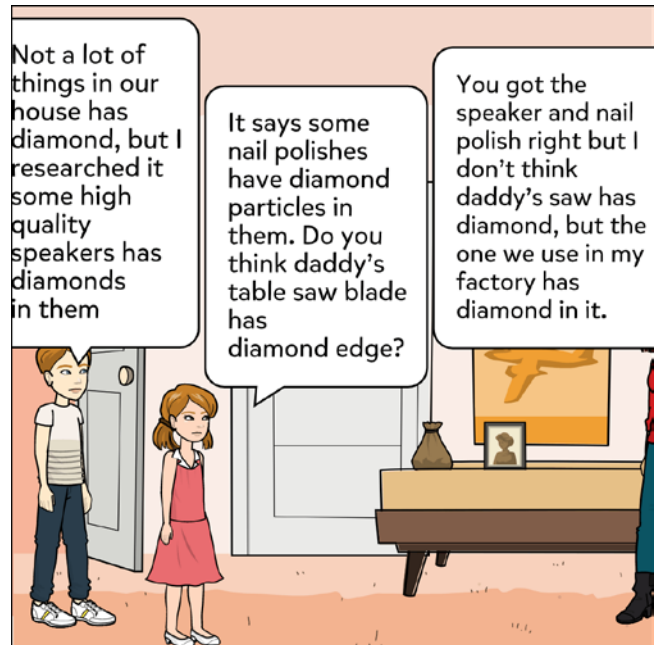
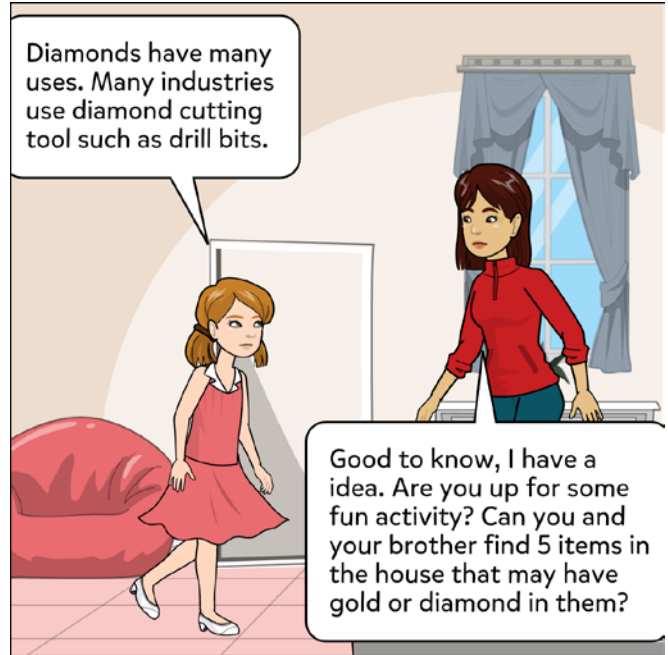


- *Canada is the fifth largest producer of Gold after, China, Australia, Russia and United States.*

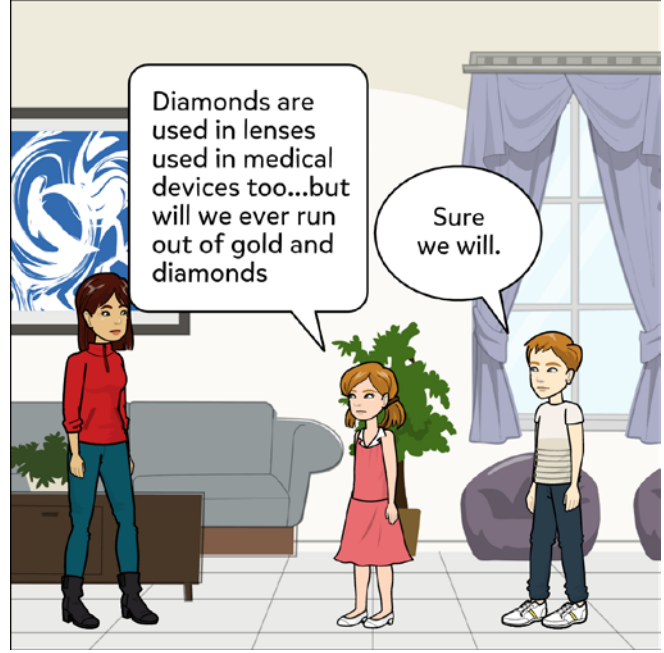

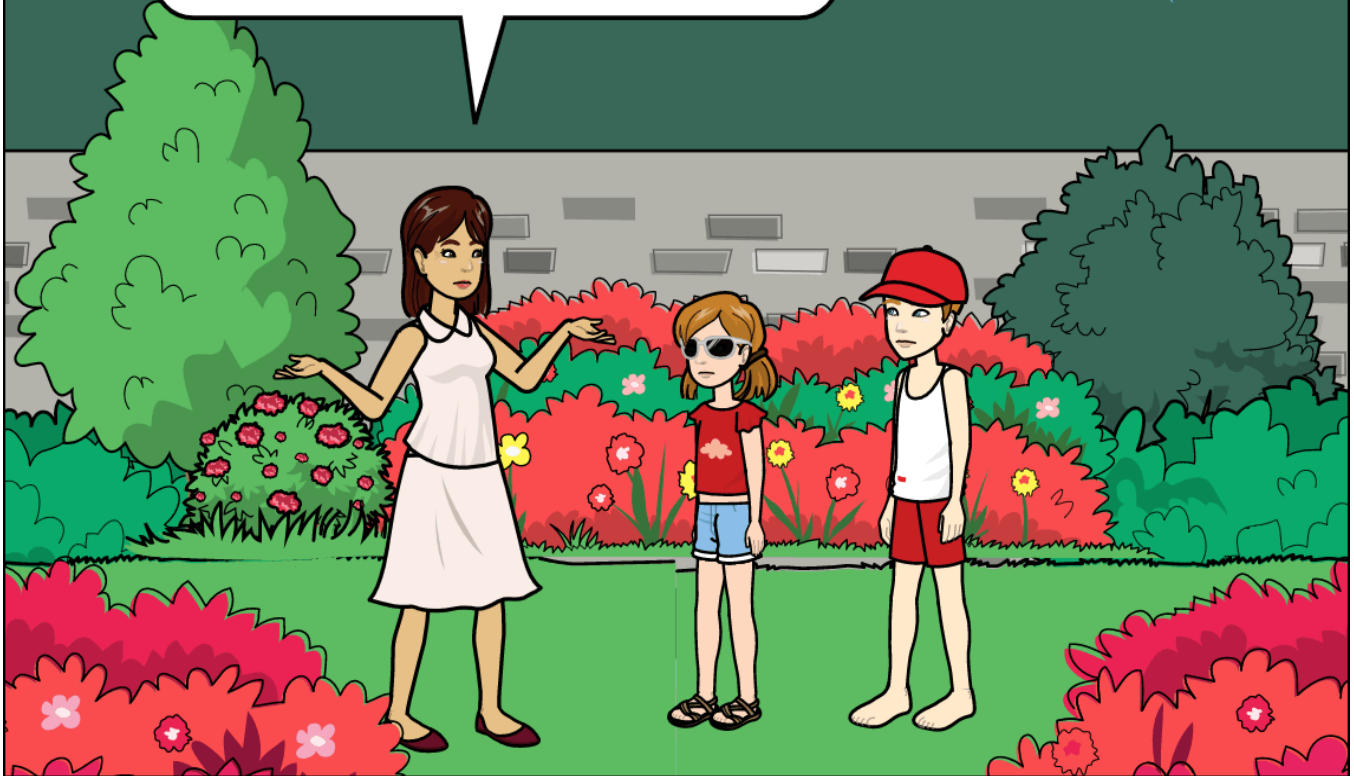
- Canada is the third largest producer of Diamond



Diamond ore are gushed in to smaller pieces, separated by size, scrubbed to remove clay and dirt, go through a cyclone like process, so the heavier part is separate from the waste, and then the X-ray process separates them further. The raw diamond it collected. Expert diamond cutters cut the stones to be a sparkling stone
